

## Step by step instructions for completing Online Elementary (Level 2) Food Hygiene (V6)

Step 1: Download, enter your name and save this <u>study logsheet</u>. Or print the logsheet and fill in your name by hand.

Step 2: Read through each of the chapters below, in order, and fill in your study logsheet as you complete each chapter. The course chapters are available to download as pdfs from the links below.

Each chapter has one or more self-assessment question (SAQs). Write down your answers to these SAQs in a notebook as you may want to show them at the start of your exam. After you have answered a set of SAQs you can compare your answers with ours which <u>are here</u>.
