

Membership of a Seafood Training Network

Key Facts

1. Seafood Training Networks are made up of members who are employers or training providers and key partners such as Seafish who have a more strategic role;
2. A Network will represent the interests of the wider fish and shellfish industry;
3. The key partners within each Network will form a Steering Group, who along with an industry-based Chairman run the network;
4. The Steering Group will consult with the employers and trainers as appropriate to find out how they would like the Network to respond to opportunities, needs and issues:
 - a. The main purpose of the Network is to support the training and educational needs of employers throughout the region covered by the Network;
 - b. A secondary purpose of the Network is to work with fish and shellfish training providers in such a way that the take up of training and learning is improved with increased benefits for employers and providers;
 - c. The Network has other objectives that are clearly stated in their Terms of Reference;
5. Membership of a Network requires employers or training providers to adhere to a few simple conditions. In return, they have an opportunity to contribute to the direction and success of the Network. The main conditions are:
 - a. To respond to requests from the Steering Group for feedback on issues as quickly as possible and within any stated reasonable deadline;
 - b. To keep confidential any information that is identified as confidential or sensitive, until it is appropriate to disclose it;
 - c. To communicate and collaborate with other members of the Network (when this is appropriate) in an open and honest way;
 - d. Consultations will be made public via the Network microsite.
6. Members contact details will be published on the Network microsite. This information can promote their businesses and includes:
 - a. Company name and hyperlink to their website;
 - b. Members may if they wish have an additional profile page on the microsite. This may be of particular interest to training providers;
 - c. Members may withdraw at any time and at that time their details will be removed ;
